Purpose of the role:

The RAF Volleyball Association is seeking a Volleyball Head Coach to lead on the development of a long-term plan for volleyball within the Service.

The successful candidate will join a committed team contributing toward the successful delivery of the RAF Central Fund and RAF Sports Strategy.

As Head Coach, you will play a pivotal role by leading the High-Performance Volleyball activities including the preparation on the Men's and Ladies squads for the Inter Services and Crown Service Tournaments. You will also oversee the coaching for the Mixed Team, utilising the RAF level 1 coaches where required, mentoring them and providing development opportunities to improve their coaching knowledge.

The applicant hired for the role will add value to an already successful programme and ensure that the Association continues to make a significant contribution to RAF Sport in general.

You will be passionate about sport and determined to play a part in building for the future. You will have an active contribution into the Development Strategy and Performance Pathway Strategy for the Association, helping shape the strategies and uphold them.

Services/deliverables:

1. Work with the RAF Volleyball Association Director of Performance on the development of a long-term plan for the Association that is ambitious in its goals and is achievable within the resources available.
2. Work with the RAF Volleyball Association Team Managers to organise and deliver an annual programme of activities that enables our players to participate, improve, compete and excel within the RAF Volleyball Association.



3. Coach volleyball to members of the RAF Volleyball Association of all abilities, from beginner through to our most talented players, and attend competitions to provide both coaching and logistical support.
4. Work collaboratively with others to ensure that our best players have the support and services they require to compete at the highest levels of competition.
5. Work with the UKAF Volleyball Association Head Coach promote suitable players to the highest level of Service Sport.
6. Actively promote the RAF to talented volleyball players and prospective Service Members by attending appropriate competitions.
7. Supervise a small team of assistant coaches who will help to deliver the programme. Using existing RAF Volleyball Association Members where appropriate, to make a positive contribution towards their development.
8. Maintain accurate records in relation to finance, Health and Safety and participation in activities, as well as maintaining an up-to-date understanding of all Association and Service policies and procedures.
